

## **Parents and Volunteers ~ Code of Conduct**

I will be positive, supportive and encouraging of my child/children.

I will encourage good sportsmanship by demonstrating positive support for all skaters, coaches, officials, other parents and volunteers at all times.

I will place the emotional and physical well being of all skaters ahead of any personal desire for my child to win.

I will support the coaches, officials, volunteers and rink personnel working with my child in order to encourage a positive and enjoyable experience for all.

I will remember that practice / test sessions, shows, seminars and competitions are for the skaters, not the adults.

I will ask my child to treat other skaters, coaches, officials, volunteers and rink personnel with respect.

I will allow the coach to be the only coach.

I will not get into arguments with parents, skaters, coaches or volunteers.

I will not use abusive or insulting language.

I will not criticize coaches, officials, volunteers or other children.

I will adhere to and will require my child/children to adhere to Freestyle Session Etiquette and Safety Rules along with Music Playing Rules and Right of Way Etiquette.

Alcohol, illegal drugs and unauthorized prescription drugs shall not be possessed, consumed or distributed before, during or after any skating event at the Greensboro Ice House, including Club ice sessions.
